

FORMAT: Weekend Individual Net

ELIGIBILITY:

All regular LVMGC members with a valid January 2022, SCGA handicap index and new members who have not established a handicap who will participate in the "A" flight.

RULES & Scoring:

- 1. Play according to 2022 USGA rules as amended by local rules.
- 2. ALL flights will play from the "White" moveable tee-box markers.
- 3. Record only your GROSS score on the score card.
- 4. Review the official score card for accuracy. Sign, and Attest the official score card and give it to a committee member at the scoring table within 10 minutes of the time you completed you round..
- 5. We are using the current handicap index in accordance with SCGA rules for this tournament
- 6. For sidepots and weekend payouts I will be calculating according to your flight. Mark down your gross score only.

Local rules -

Free relief from smut grass, footprints in bunkers and tree roots

Do not go back to the tee for a lost ball. Play as an unplayable from spot ball was lost and agreed to by your playing partners, you will be lying 3 (hitting 4) taking a 2 stroke penalty. It is preferable that you hit a provisional ball if you think your ball won't be found.

Pace of Play guidelines are in use and will be enforced, 41/2 hours is the maximum.

Payment and Sign Up

Sign ups open February 1, 2022. Do not submit entry prior, it will not help you! Entries coming in early may be deprioritized.

To sign up, send \$85 via Paypal to LV2017MENSCLUB@GMAIL.COM Be sure to add a note with the players name and any other players being paid for. Indicate who you want to play with and have selected the "Sending to a Friend" option. It costs the club \$2.95 if you don't, that amount is subtracted from the prize fund if you can't follow directions. Last month the prize fund was reduced by over \$140 due to people who chose not to do this correctly. This month, anyone who does not follow this direction will have any winnings reduced by \$5.

Handicap Chair Jesper Lykke

A note from your Handicap Chair:

Although it may look great to be a single handicapper, golfers that post lower scores than they shoot cheat only themselves. Conversely, players that post higher scores than they should or fail to post some of their good rounds, cheat everybody else!

Based on rumors and hearsay, I decided to try to determine what is truly going on with regards to our Indexes, and earlier this month I downloaded all posted rounds by all members in 2021 and sorted the more than 25,000 rounds into the following categories for each member: Tournament, Home, and Away.

I then compared the Average Score Differential between scores posted for Tournaments and for non-Tournaments (Home and Away), and my findings surprised me:

129 shot equal to or better in tournaments than in non-tournament rounds,

81 shot more than 1 stroke better in tournaments than in non-tournament rounds,

28 shot more than 3 strokes better in tournaments than in non-tournament rounds,

10 shot more than 5 strokes better in tournaments than in non-tournament rounds,

5 shot more than 7 strokes better in tournaments than in non-tournament rounds, and

2 members shot more than 9 strokes better in tournaments than in non-tournament rounds?

My initial conclusion was that several members have a Handicap Index that is out of whack and should be corrected, but also that it was not my decision alone! Appreciating that mitigating factors could be at play, the Board directed the Handicap Committee to take a closer look at the numbers and report back, and I am pleased to announce that Paul Hendricksen and Ben Serns have volunteered join the committee.

I have also sought input and directions from the SCGA to learn more about standards and procedures, and I am committed to do right by <u>all</u> members. That means that adjustments will be made, where warranted, but also that no adjustments will be made without a dialogue with the respective member(s) first!

According to Golf Digest, the odds of shooting a score lower than your course handicap is 1:5, shooting three strokes lower is 1:20, and eight strokes lower is 1:1,138!

I hope that every member will have a chance to enjoy the wonderful experience of an exceptional score, because it both can and will happen, and when it does happen it should be celebrated in the bar after the round! However, the odds against being able to do so several times in a year – and in tournaments only – are astronomical and deserves a second look.

I will keep members posted and our findings will be shared, as we learn more.

May we post as often as we play, and may we post with the same diligence and honesty, as we play the game!


