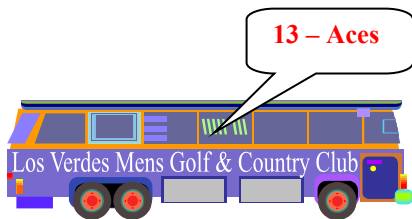

IMPORTANT! YOU MUST READ THIS BEFORE SIGNING UP FOR THE APRIL TOURNAMENT

Entries for the April monthly tournament open April 1, 2022 at 6:00am. Early payments will be returned for resubmission.

NEW PAYPAL ACCOUNT

You must be careful to change this in your PayPal application if you didn't last month.

If you have paid LVMGCC previously to the old account, you will need to delete it

You will need to enter the new PayPal account lvmgccgolf@gmail.com

You still must use the "Pay to a Friend" option entries that don't will be rejected for resubmission in the correct format.

You still need to complete the NOTE section with your name and playing partners. Ideally you will have agreement from the other players. Don't indicate people you would "like" to play with.

Call them, ask and have an agreement before entering.

Tournament Formats: **2 Man Best Ball SCGA Qualifier (Blue Tees)** and **2 Man Best Ball Competition (White Tees)** Both will have the same payouts, just different flights and different tees obviously. *Only those playing in the Blue flight can qualify for the SCGA Championship.*

With this format, you will be competing along with 1 other partner. It would be delightful if everyone indicates in the NOTE section of their PayPal entry who they are playing with. Nice, clean notes would look like:

"Entry for John Smith. Playing with John Doe Blue Tees. Paired with Bob Ace and Joe Jones Blue Tees."

If you are paying for more than 1 player:

"Entry paying for John Smith, John Doe Blue Tees, and Steve Jones, Bob Johnson White Tees"

Do not include requests for certain tee times or other nice comments for me it makes it more difficult to handle the data.

You can enter as a twosome or as a single and I will pair you to make a foursome. You can mix and match twosomes playing White and Blue tees.

Chose your partner wisely they will determine your success in this format... sometimes known as "screw your buddy".

Tournament Captain Paul Hendrickson, paul@tmadeco.com will be looking for volunteers as usual to help run the tournament and make a great day for all the players. If you are playing early or late, think about taking a late or early shift. Big thanks to all who have helped this year!

Local Rule for Smut Grass :

A player whose ball lies close to smutgrass, in a position where the swing movement of the clubface to hit the ball is obstructed by the smutgrass, is allowed to place the ball within one club length of where the ball came to rest no nearer the hole without penalty. There is no relief for stance on smutgrass, only the clubface obstruction.

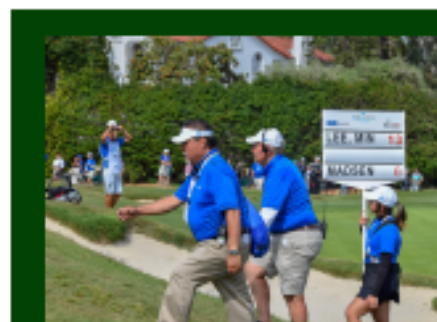
