

All skins carry the same value across all flights. With the value determined by the total number of skins.

What a great day it was weatherwise again. Looking forward to the upcoming May event, the Tin Whistle...

Tin Whistle: This is an individual event. Points are awarded based on the **net score** a player makes on a hole.

Points are awarded for:

- Net Pars +1
- Birdies +3
- Eagles +7

Points are deducted for:

- Bogey -1
- Double Bogey or worse -3

The scoring is by flights. Pick up your ball when you are at net Double Bogey, that is the max score.

I'll get out the tournament flyer by tomorrow when entries open.

Here is a tricky one and it affects the entire membership. It's a question of whether you are in bounds or out of bounds. Lost or Found?

Pace of play is extremely important:

No Re-teeing once you leave the tee box

A player has one chance to take a provisional tee shot if the ball is possibly lost or out of play within our tournament play. There will be no going back to the tee box to re-tee. If your ball is not found within the allotted 3 minute time period you will drop from the point of entry and go across to the edge of the fairway perpendicular to the point of entry to going out of bounds or lost. You then get a 2 club length relief, then you get a drop from your knee perpendicular to the point of entry at the edge of the fairway. You are in play hitting 4.
