

Golf Genius Tips

This month's tip will assist you if you are having troubles **Registering** for tournaments via **Golf Genius** if you are having troubles.

I highly recommend registering via a computer rather than a mobile device as it is an easier transaction with a stable network connection. If you are using a mobile device, please make sure you are connected to a stable network, and I would use caution if you're just using it over with cellular data connection.

Logout of Golf Genius!

The most common problem I see, is that members are currently logged in to Golf Genius from a previous tournament or another club. Please logout of Golf Genius prior to clicking on the registration link. Our system is not set-up to have a Username / Password to use Golf Genius. All you need is the GGID of the tournament to complete your registration.

If **you are NOT receiving** our tournament invite emails from Golf Genius, please check your Spam/Junk folder for emails from norply@golfgenius.com.

We also recommend you add that address to your address book which will most likely end up in your inbox.

If you would like to have quick and easy access to all the events available for our members, we suggest that you add this link https://www.golfgenius.com/ggid/qtttph to your favor-

ites.

By simply clicking on the link, you will be able to view all the past and present events, and from there you can access each event portal. You can then use the portal to sign up for a tournament, check tee sheets, or view the results of past tournaments.

September Rules Updates – How to fill out a scorecard!!

Important Rules to remember:

- 1) When filling out your card for the round we will have one person who is scoring in Golf Genius and one who has the official scorecard which will be turned in at the end of the round. Remember golf genius is not the source of the truth...your official scorecard is and should be compared against golf genius.
- 2) You should only be recording GROSS scores in both golf genius and your official scorecard. Not net scores, not 1's and 0's or any other creative way you like you score your card. For our tournaments gross scores are all you need so please keep it simple.
- 3) It is worth noting that we do appreciate you adding up your scores at the end of the round but you will not be penalized if you incorrectly add up your nines and 18-hole scores...but you do need to make sure your hole by hole is correct and signed for.
 - A. Please be aware if you sign for a lower score, you will be disqualified from the tournament.
 - B. If you sign for a higher score, you must keep that score after the card is signed for.

If you have any questions or concerns with the above, please do not hesitate to contact me (LVMGCRules@gmail.com) and I would be happy to talk through all the scenarios this may not have covered.

Handicap Chair Thoughts

Jesper Lykke Posting your Rounds

Greetings to all. I truly hope you are enjoying the game this summer, the comradeship, and all the various tournaments that the club is running.



Tournaments are great fun, and because of the International Handicapping system, tournaments are fair and equitable regardless of our respective levels of the game. If done right, and if all play by the rules, a member with an Index of 8 can have a very even match against any other golfers playing to a 5 or a 15... However, for us to accomplish that modest ambition, everybody must stop cheating! Yes, what you call sandbagging, I call cheating.... A little here and a little there - it all adds up, and suddenly, the fun of playing in tournaments has totally vanished! So, allow me to remind the membership of some must-follow rules:

You must post your <u>all</u> your scores: Home, Competitive Home, Away, and Competitive Away!

At many competitive rounds / tournaments, the club will post for you, but it is your responsibility to ensure that your scores have been posted. PERIOD! Don't settle for posting only the bad Away scores, when nobody can check you (you know who you are)!

Post all your scores, because that is the only way the Handicap System can work to everybody's benefit. You don't improve your lie, you don't miss four consecutive 1-footers, and you post everything! Don't forget that our beloved Game of Golf is based on the honor system, and that players call penalties on themselves...

If you shoot high scores on a couple of holes, use the GHIN App to make it easier to ensure that the maximum of "Net Double Bogey" is posted for Handicap purposes. You do that best by posting hole by hole in the APP immediately after your round.

You must post all acceptable scores on the day played because your Handicap Index is re-calculated after each day of play. An Acceptable score is defined not by how well you played – or didn't play, but whether you played at least 14 holes out of 18 or at least 7 out of 9! The holes you didn't play should be posted as your most likely score or net double bogey, whichever is lower!

Do not forget to also post your Match Play rounds! There are various circumstances that might result in you starting a hole but not holing out. For example:

The result of the hole has already been decided.

A hole has been conceded in match play.

Your partner has already posted a better score in a Four-Ball format.

You have already reached the net double bogey limit on a specific hole. In all such situations, you must record your most likely score or net double bogey, whichever is lower! ALWAYS!

There is some merit to not posting a practice round, if indeed that is what it is. However, unless a practice round is declared as such prior to teeing off, it is not a practice round and must be posted!

I am not in my role to police members, but to try to ensure that we can enjoy our game, and for all to enjoy it, all must play fairly – especially when it comes to posting!
